- Submit a Completed J-1 Summer Work and Travel Application Form
- Payment of non-refundable Registration and Orientation fee of \$7000JMD
- Payment of first deposit of \$350USD, due one (1) week after payment of registration & orientation fee.

All documents must be submitted to complete your registration process.

50% of the balance is due on or before December 28th, 2020 with the final 50% due on or before January 31st, 2021.

All program fees must be paid in the account provided.

Step 2: Job Selection

- Create a skype account
- Select your preferred job from the list you will be provided with
- Interview with the respective employers and sponsor
- Confirm employment and housing
- Apply for a transcript from your institution (G.P.A. must be 2.0 and above)
- Complete program fee payment

Step 3: Visa Application

- Orientation for the program
- Completion of U.S. visa application form
- Collect visa appointment package
- Attend U.S. visa interview

Step 4: Bon Voyage!

- Make flight arrangements
- Update arrival information on sponsor's portal
- Upon arrival, activate SEVIS and apply for your Social Security Number
